How do myki fares compare?



myki fares are based on the existing value Metcard system. Where like products are available, you will pay no more when you switch from Metcard to myki. In fact, you could save money.

A myki can store both myki money (a dollar amount) and myki pass (travel days). So it will suit you no matter how you travel.

myki will suit you whether you're a daily or an occasional traveller

Your myki can hold both myki money (a dollar amount) and a myki pass (travel days).

myki money

Is a dollar amount stored on your myki.

Works like a debit card for travel.

Automatically calculates the lowest fare.

Is best for you if your travel patterns vary and you like to pay as you go.

myki pass

Value stored as consecutive travel days.

Stores 7 or any number of days between 28 and 365 days in selected zones.

Is best for you if you travel regularly in the same zone(s).
